## **Course contents**

The travel companies has always adjusted itself to the requirements of the time. A circus enterprise of today cannot work without modern equipment. But the change of time confronts most enterprises in that field with a lot of problems. Many events take place on short notice and appropriate constructions have to be erected in short time. The industry has reacted to that challenge and has developed possibilities of setting up mobile constructions and tents. Considering this situation, there is a growing demand for experienced and skilled workers, knowing how to deal with mobile tents, stages and exhibitions stands. Our training is the answer to this demand.

### **Module 1**

Art and culture in a technical context, the culture, history and development of the circus trade and artistry, with emphasis on technical requirements. Requirements of today for the travelling trade and artistry. Stage work, individual stage design and the appropriate technique for the setup. Basic math.

### **Module 2**

Legal regulations, rules and regulations for the technical area of the travelling trade.

Industrial safety regulation, First Aid. Applying traditional handicraft for the circus trade and complying with safety standards.

### **Module 3 English**

Terminology and definitions in technical areas and trades (metal, wood, electricity and textile).

Technical documentations and manuals.

Communication in technical fields: understanding, teamwork, cooperation..

#### **Module 4**

Executing the complete process of erecting and taking down a chapiteau (big top) including technical facilities; carrying out jobs related to circus work like assisting artists in the arena, lunging jobs with animals and people, jobs as illuminator, prop master, assistant prop master, entrance control, selling small articles.

#### **Module 5 Maintenance and repairing**

Maintenance and repairs as well as restoration of the tents and traditional and modern caravans and mobile homes.

#### **Module 6 Fire safety engineer (appointed by the company)**

Responsibilities and regulations for fire protection in the circus trade, physiochemical basics of fire extinction, different alarm systems for fire and danger, analysis of fire protection measurements, fire proofing management, explosions risks, execution of evacuations. Final test.
